EVENT SPECIFICATIONS

- Vendor area is in the parking lots on the west side of Bullard Street at 8th Street. Spaces will be assigned on a first-come first served basis as applications & fees are received.
- No City Vending permit is required.
- Booth spaces are approx. 10 ft. wide x 15 ft. deep.
- Space is limited and specific locations are reserved on a first-come first-served basis.
- Vendors must supply their own tents, chairs, and tables.
- Tents must be secured with 50 lb. sandbags or equivalent PER POLE. Visibly flag tie-downs.
- If you intend to use a vending truck, or otherwise require an unusual configuration, please describe, so we may assign you a proper location: _____
- Electricity is limited and available on a first-come first-served basis. Vendors must supply their own electrical cords. Cords must be completely covered and taped down.
- Generators **MUST** be approved in advance.
- Water availability is limited. Please provide your own water! A self-contained system is optimum.
- Check if you need: electricity

- Exposed grills, smokers, etc., must have a barrier to avoid potential burns.
- Vendors using grills, smokers, or any other flame/heat source must have a fire extinguisher.
- Set-up is Saturday, Dec. 3, beginning at 7:30am. Set-up must be completed by 9:30am.
- **All booths MUST remain open between 10:00am and 3:00pm, even if you sell out.**
- Vendor spaces may be broken down beginning at 3:00pm, and all materials must be completely off-site by 5:00pm.
- NOT ALLOWED: Dangerously hot exhibit lights (such as halogen); combustible or explosive materials; items stacked at heights which could possibly fall; items that could cause tripping; extremely sharp items; or any items of potential danger to the public.
- NO ALCOHOL or ILLEGAL DRUGS ALLOWED ON FESTIVAL GROUNDS. NO EXCEPTIONS!

SPECIAL INFO FOR FOOD & BEVERAGE VENDORS

- Vendors must comply with NM Dept. of Health standards. For details, See http://www.nmenv.state.nm.us/fod/Food_Program/applications.html.
- ALL FOOD must be prepared in a commercial kitchen; we have a list of kitchens available for free use, please call for details.
- All food vendors need either a year-round or temporary Food Service Permit from the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED). The Food Service Permit Application and a list of NMED Field Offices can be found online at www.nmenv.state.nm.us. The Grant County NMED Field Office is at 3082 32nd St. Bypass, Suite D, in Silver City, phone 575-388-1934.
